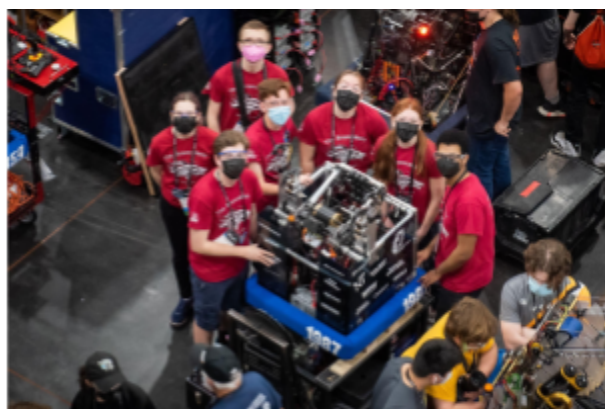

Student Interviews

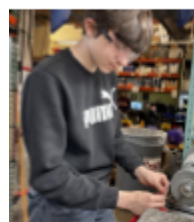
