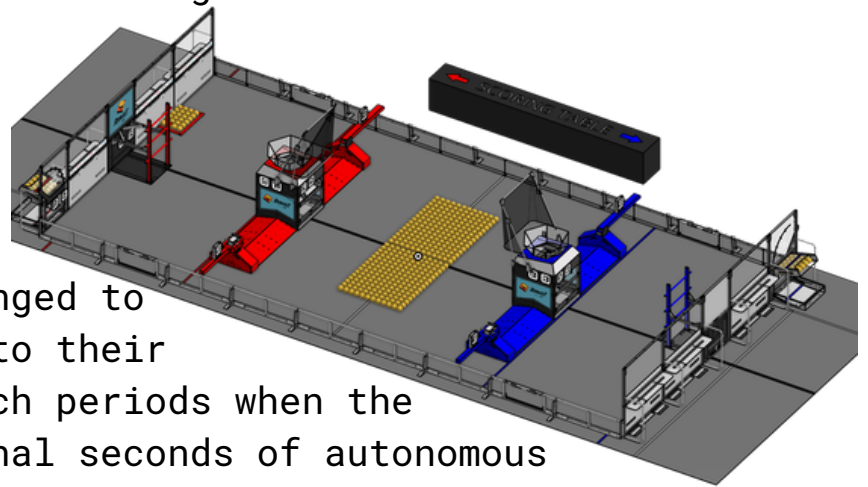

In Rebuilt, robots are challenged to shoot yellow foam balls into their respective hubs during match periods when the hubs are active. In the final seconds of autonomous and the end of the match, robots can climb the "tower" ladder for additional points. What makes this year's game so unique is the concept: it's essentially a collection of old games mashed up and made anew.
